Dear Families,

I have just finished a LiveStream with the Secretary of the DoE and this has clarified the situation in our schools:

1. Only students, whose parents are in essential services should attend school from after today and this may continue into the beginning of Term 2
2. If any student is unwell they need to stay home to get better and minimise risk to other students and staff
3. All lesson delivery will be delivered in the same format, whether at school or home. Teachers will only supervise and not teach from tomorrow
4. Lesson delivery will be designed to provide continuity, but will have a different structure to learning at school
5. Students attending school are expected to support good hygiene and social distancing requests.

For our school, online learning is available through Google Classroom and we have trial lessons scheduled for this week, which will continue to operate. We will most likely have some written materials sent out to support the online platform. Learning this week may be a little disjointed, but we are working hard to deliver both a workable structure and support system for all our students.

For Year 12 students, the NESAs Board meets tomorrow and we will let you know of the outcomes of their decision making as soon as we do.
